Volunteer Referee Points

U10/U12 REFEREE POINTS

- HOME TEAM MUST PROVIDE 2 CERTIFIED REFEREES (ONE AS CENTER AND ONE AS THE ASSISTANT REFEREE), FOR THE GAME IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THEIR GAME.
- VISITING TEAM MUST PROVIDE 1 CERTIFIED REFEREE TO BE THE AR (ASSISTANT REFEREE) FOR THE GAME IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THEIR GAME.
- IF YOUR TEAM IS SCHEDULED FOR THE LAST GAME OF THE DAY THEN YOUR REFEREE ASSIGNMENT IS FOR THE FIRST GAME OF THE DAY - WITH THE ABOVE MENTIONED NUMBERS OF REFEREES.
- 1 REFEREE POINT WILL BE AWARDED PER WEEK, FOR TEAMS THAT FULFILL THEIR REFEREE REQUIREMENTS.
- ANY TEAM THAT FAILS TO FULFILL THE REFEREE REQUIREMENT MORE THAN 3 WEEKS IN A SEASON WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR LEAGUE OR AREA PLAYOFFS.

U14 REFEREE POINTS

- THE HOME AND VISITING TEAM MUST EACH PROVIDE 1 CERTIFIED REFEREE TO BE AN ASSISTANT REFEREE FOR THE GAME IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THEIR GAME.
- IF YOUR TEAM IS SCHEDULED FOR THE LAST GAME OF THE DAY THEN YOUR REFEREE ASSIGNMENT IS FOR THE FIRST GAME OF THE DAY - WITH THE ABOVE MENTIONED NUMBER OF REFEREES.
- 1 REFEREE POINT WILL BE AWARDED PER WEEK, FOR TEAMS THAT FULFILL THEIR REFEREE REQUIREMENTS.
- ANY TEAM THAT FAILS TO FULFILL THE REFEREE REQUIREMENT MORE THAN 3 WEEKS IN A SEASON WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR LEAGUE OR AREA PLAYOFFS.

TO RECEIVE THE REFEREE POINTS -

- ✓ A REFEREE MUST BE TRAINED AND CERTIFIED.
- ✓ THE REFEREE MUST WEAR THE PROPER UNIFORM AND BADGE.
- ✓ LINE-UP CARDS MUST HAVE THE REFEREE'S NAME AND TEAM (DIVISION/GENDER/NUMBER) THAT THEY ARE REPRESENTING PRINTED ON THE BACK OF THE GAME CARD THAT THEY OFFICIATE AND PUT INTO THE GAME CARD BOX.
- ✓ ALL REFEREE MUST BE SCHEDULED THROUGH THE ONLINE REFEREE SCHEDULER, OR THROUGH THE APPROPRIATE REFEREE SCHEDULER BY 8:00PM TUESDAY EVENING.
- ✓ IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM TO CHECK THE ONLINE SCHEDULE FOR ANY CHANGES THAT MIGHT HAVE BEEN MADE.

WE RECOMMEND THAT THE CERTIFIED REFEREE NOT BE THE COACH, SO THAT HE CAN HAVE TIME TO DEBRIEF HIS TEAM AFTER THE GAME.

All Referee Points are subject to review by the Regional Referee Administrator and Regional Commissioner.
